

# Campus Hazing Transparency Report

In alignment with the [Stop Campus Hazing Act](#) (SCHA), Wisconsin Statute § 948.51, and Section 485(f) of the Higher Education Act of 1965, Madison College maintains and publicly reports substantiated findings of hazing violations involving student organizations, athletic teams, or groups.

The Campus Hazing Transparency Report includes violations of Madison College's [Code of Conduct](#), [Anti-Hazing Policy](#), and applicable state or federal laws related to hazing or associated misconduct, including alcohol, drug, physical assault, or sexual assault violations, when connected to hazing activity.

This report lists recognized student organizations, athletic teams, or groups that have been found responsible for violating Madison College's Anti-Hazing Policy through the college's formal conduct process. Reported information includes, when available, the name of the organization or group, the date(s) of the hazing behavior, the investigation and adjudication timeline, and a summary description of the findings. Only cases resulting in a final determination of responsibility, including the conclusion of any applicable appeal process, are included. Individual student names are not published.

Reports of alleged hazing that do not result in a finding of responsibility are not included. The college's definition of hazing is broader than federal and state definitions and may encompass a wider range of behaviors.

The Campus Hazing Transparency Report is updated as outcomes are finalized and is shared with the campus community at least twice per year, typically during the fall and spring semesters. All published hazing-related violations are maintained and publicly available for a minimum of five years, in accordance with federal law.
